Additional Information for you to keep and some of your questions answered

This information forms part of the application and should be read, understood and accepted before you sign the application form.

The Fund:

The Fund was set up by a legacy from the late Brain Sellars.

In his younger days he was connected with the 46th Sheffield (St Paul's, Norton Lees) Scout Group.

On his death, his executors agreed that Sheaf District Scouts (the Sheffield Sheaf District Scout Council) was the most appropriate to administer the Fund.

Fund's Purpose:

The Purpose is to provide deserving youth in the area covered by Sheffield Sheaf Scout District, with financial assistance towards worthwhile and character building activities

How is the Fund managed?

The Trustees of the Fund are the Sheaf District Executive Committee, and they have appointed an Investment Committee, which includes some Trustees to manage the Fund on a day-to-day basis and approve grants on its behalf.

How old do I have to be?

The fund is aimed at young people between the ages of 14 and 25 years, applications outside of these ages may be considered at the discretion of the Trustees.

Do I have to be a member of the Scouts?

No, not necessarily but you have to live or attend a youth organisation that meets in the area covered by the Sheaf Scout District. Advice on this can be obtained from the Trustees.

Is there anything you will not give a grant for?

Yes, we do not fund equipment, vehicles or the employment of young people or adults. Generally we do not fund coaching or other qualifications or Scout Adult Leader Training.

Will my application details remain confidential?

The Committee undertake to stay within the rule of the Data Protection Act and will only circulate personal Information between members of the committee and the trustees of Sheaf District Scout.

Do you give grants retrospectively?

All applications must be reviewed prior to the event taking place. Retrospect applications will not be considered

The decision of the Trustees is final.
